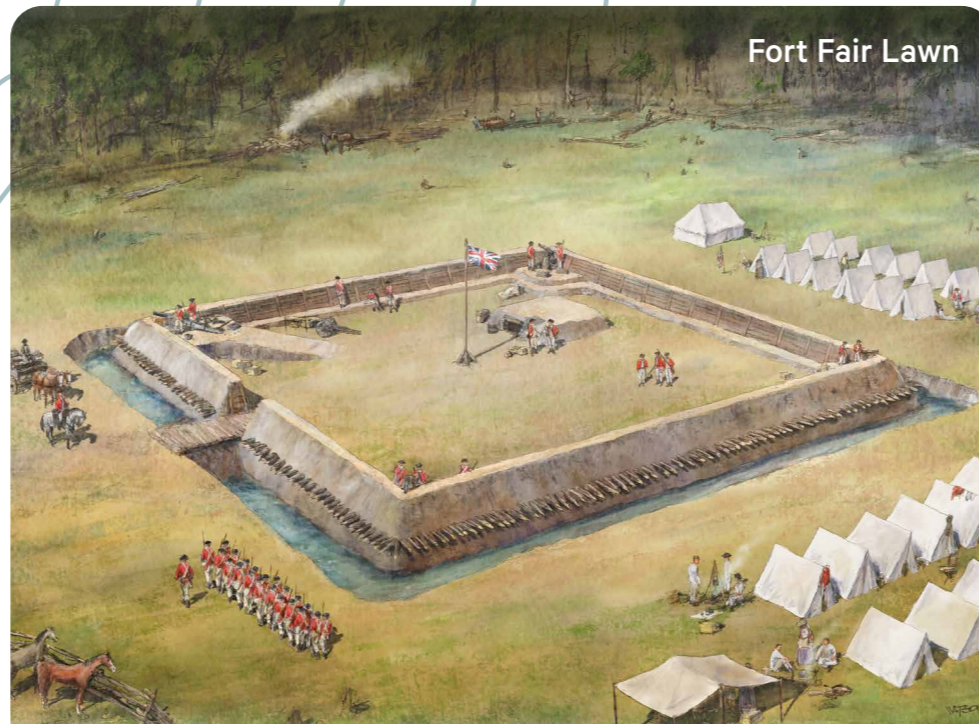


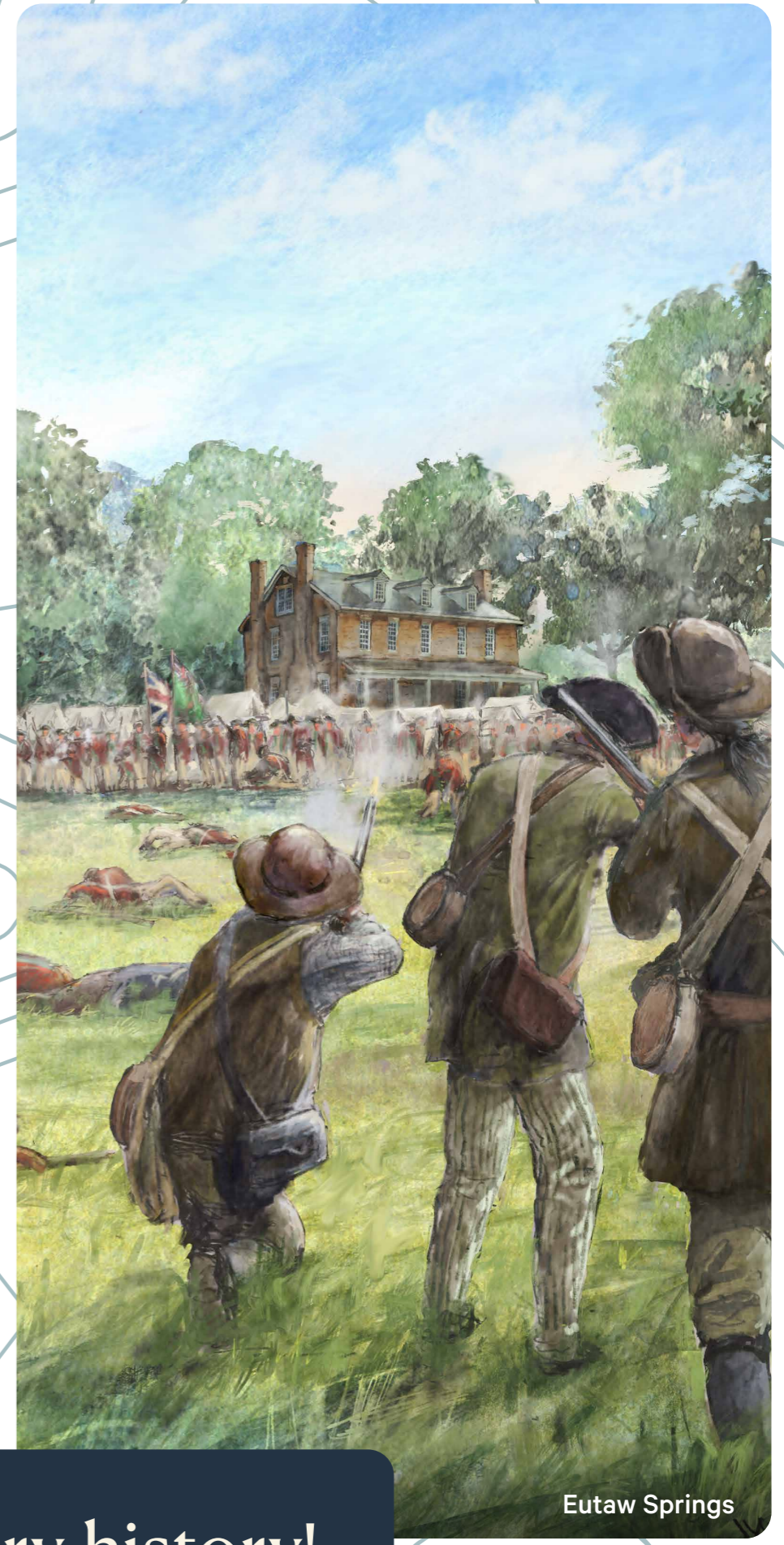

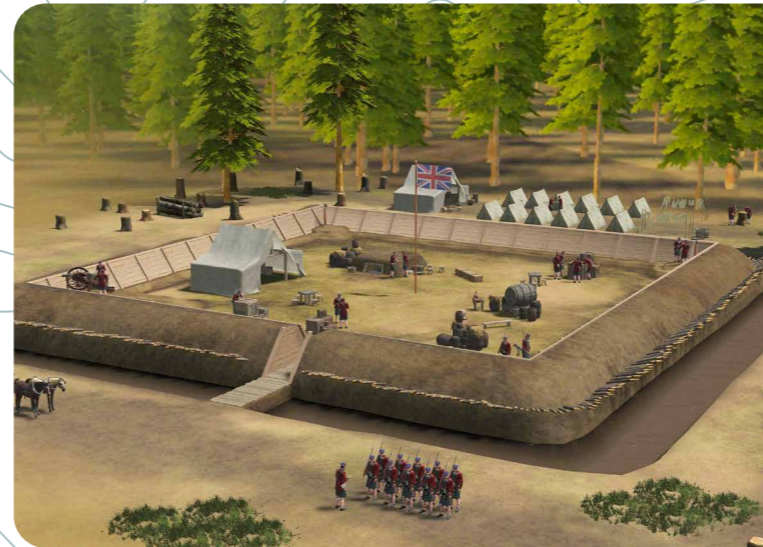

## Go back in time and explore these places



### Fort Fair Lawn

Revisit the soldier's campsite stationed at Fort Fair Lawn, an earthen fortification built by the British in 1780. Learn about the different methods of defense used by soldiers at the Fort during the Revolutionary War, including a palisade and cannons!



### Eutaw Springs

Witness the during and aftermath of the Battle of Eutaw Springs on September 8th 1781, one of the final Revolutionary battles in South Carolina. Explore the brick house and British camp located at the center of the battlefield as the action unfolds.



### Marion Square

Reinstate the Horn Work, a massive Patriot fortification designed to protect the City of Charleston and its vital port. Watch during and after the Siege of Charleston in early 1780, as the British claim victory and the patriots surrender their monumental fort.
